2010 World Field Championships Scores

Following request for the Archery Australia Board to review the MQS scores for the 2010 World Field Championships the Board at its last meeting on Sunday 28th February 2010 reviewed the score and submissions.

It should be noted that although the World Field Championships is a self funded event it is the policy of the Archery Australia Board that we send only the best-qualified archers to represent the country and not simply send people who can pay their way.

In the past the MQS score has been determined by reviewing the results of the previous championships using the first cut score as the MQS score.

This was not possible for this year's event as many divisions at the 2008 World Field Championships were unable to complete the Ranking Rounds (24 target unmarked and 24 target marked) due to weather condition. So the scores for the 2006 World Field Championships was used and converted from the old maximum 5 points per arrow scoring to the new maximum 6 point per arrow scoring using the Rating Tables.

There was also some liberty take to update the score to better reflect the current world standard.

The scores have been reviewed and it was agreed by the Archery Australia Board that some scores would be changed, see that list below.

All other conditions for team selection will apply only the MQS scores have been changed.
