ROUNDS:	CANBERRA	Junior & Cadet Boys & Girls	(60m, 50m, 40m)
	SHORT CANBERRA	Intermediate Boys & Girls	(50m, 40m, 30m)
	JUNIOR CANBERRA	Cub Boys & Girls	(40m, 30m, 20m)
	MINI CANBERRA	Cub Boys & Girls less than 10years	(30m, 20m, 10m)

PERIOD: Competition to be held during the months of **August, September and October 2008.**

AGE GROUPS: Compound, Recurve, Longbow, Bare-bow & Crossbow.
Archers can enter in divisions at or above their age group, but they cannot go down and age group.

Juniors:

If you turn 18 during 2008, you are a Junior until 31.12.2008.

If you turn 17 during 2008, you are a Junior until 31.12.2009.

Cadets:

If you turn 16 during 2008, you are a cadet until 31.12.2008 and then you become a Junior 1.1.2009.

If you turn 15 during 2008, you are a cadet until 31.12.2009 and then you become a Junior 1.1.2010.

Intermediates:

If you turn 14 during 2008, you are an intermediate until 31.12.2008 and then you become a cadet on 1.1.2009.

If you turn 13 during 2008, you are intermediate until 31.12.2009 and then you become a cadet on 1.1.2010.

Cubs:

If you turn 12 during 2008, you are a cub until 31.12.2008 and then you become an intermediate on 1.1.2009.

If you turn 11 during 2008, you are a cub until 31.12.2009 and then you become an intermediate on 1.1.2010.

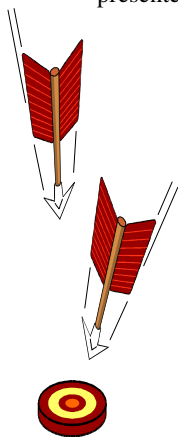
If you turn 10 during 2008, you are a cub until 31.12.2010 and then you become an intermediate on 1.1.2011.

If you turn 9 during 2008, you are a cub until 31.12.2011 and then you become an intermediate on 1.1.2012.

ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per entrant, in each division entered.

AWARDS:

- "Silver Arrow" Necklaces with the year inscribed on the back, will be awarded to the top Boy & Girl, Recurve & Compound.
- Certificates will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placing's in each division.
- At the current time I am negotiating with a number of corporate organisations with the view of providing an appropriate prize pool for the winners (Additional details will be provided once agreement has been made).
- All competitors will be eligible to receive a Participation Sticker from their RGB Youth Development Officer, which will highlight the year and score achieved. (Participation Stickers can be obtained by contacting this office)
- Results will be published in the Archery E-News. Overall Winners and 1st, 2nd & 3rd place competitors will be presented with their awards at the 2009 Junior National Archery Championships, being held during January.
