2012 SENIOR TEAM SELECTION CRITERIA for **2012 Senior National Championships**

Archers wishing to represent SQAS on the Senior Team (maximum of 4 men recurve, 4 women recurve, 4 men compound and 4 women compound) at the **2012 Senior Nationals** to be held in Tuggernong ACT 25-30 March 2012, will need to fulfil the following criteria in order to be eligible for possible selection.

Selection Event Dates:

Field Event: Sunday, 19 February 2012 (SQAS Field Course, Belmont)
Target Event: Sunday, 4 March 2012 (GCTA)

Format:

Field: 24 FITA Marked FITA Round
Target: FITA Round

Minimum Standard:

In general, a minimum standard of mid First Class will apply.

FINAL RANKING

The Target score and the Field score of each archer will be added together and the archers then ranked accordingly in each Division.

TEAM SELECTION

In each division, the top four ranking archers who have met the above requirements and who have entered both the Target and Field events at the 2012 National Championships will be invited on the SQAS Senior Team. Should an archer not accept their position for any reason then the next ranked qualifying archer will be invited and so on until the team is filled, if possible. As it is preferable to fill the team if possible, the Committee may at their discretion include an archer(s) whose scores were not of Mid First Class standard for their Division.

Archers invited on the SQAS team will be required to sign an agreement that they will abide by the conditions as set out in this Team Selection Criteria.

TEAM FUNDING

The amount of financial assistance to team members will be decided by SQAS each year, taking into account the location of the Nationals, the number of archers in the team and the funding available. Should an archer be selected whose score was not of the required standard, then a reduced sponsorship (or none) may be provided.

Any funding support will be paid after the Nationals and on advice from the Team Manager as to the good conduct of the archer and that the criteria have been met.

TEAM UNIFORM

SQAS will provide team members with an SQAS team shirt (if required that year). Tracksuits are also available but are at the archer's own cost.

Team members will be required to wear the SQAS shirt during the Official Opening, Photographs, Official Practice, media interviews, Award presentations and at other times as requested by the Team Manager.

It is also desirable for team members to wear the SQAS shirt during competition but this is not compulsory.

GENERAL

The SQAS Management Committee's decisions with respect to selection and the interpretation of these criteria shall be final.
