SQAS CHAMPIONSHIP GUIDELINES 2012

(Adopted SQAS AGM 19.02.05)
(Fees updated 19.04.06)
(Updated 24.07.11)

These guidelines have been prepared for clubs hosting SQAS Championship events such as the SQAS Target, Short Range, Clout, Flight and Field Championships and FITA Star shoots tournaments. Separate guidelines are available for SQAS Silver Arrow inter-club events.

Host clubs of SQAS Championships and FITA Star tournaments, as listed in the SQAS shooting Calendar, are responsible for organising the event and ensuring all arrangements are in hand. In particular host clubs are to liaise regularly with the SQAS Tournament Secretary to ensure that all arrangements are in hand and that there is no confusion of responsibilities.

Advertising

The SQAS Tournament Secretary shall advertise championship, FITA Stars tournament events, unless agreed otherwise by the SQAS Tournament Secretary.

Medals

For championships the host club shall liaise with the SQAS Recorder to arrange for the production of medals. It is essential to give the SQAS Recorder 14 days clear notice to enable engraving and dispatching.

Fees

The following fee structure shall apply unless agreed otherwise by SQAS Management Committee;

(A) SQAS FITA Star - double	Adult \$40	Minors \$30	
(B) SQAS Championship- Target	Adult \$40	Minors \$30	
- Flight	Adult \$20	Minors \$20	
- Clout	Adult \$20	Minors \$20	
- Indoor	Adult \$60	Minors \$50	
- Field	Adult \$30	Minors \$25	
- Short Range	Adult \$25	Minors \$25	
(C) Target QRE	-single 72	Adult \$10	Minors \$8
	-double 144	Adult \$15	Minors \$10

For all (B) SQAS Championship events i.e., Target, Short Range, Clout and Flight, Field and Indoor Championships and for (A) FITA Stars:

- Entry fees shall be paid to SQAS
- The host club shall supply target faces and score cards but SQAS shall meet their cost.
- SQAS will meet the cost of judges fees, (\$25 per day for judging whether shooting or not, and if not shooting, travel expenses of 25 cents per km and may meet accommodation if agreed prior).
- For the Indoor in 2012 SQAS shall pay the cost of the venue and power.
- Host clubs shall receive from the fees a return of:
 - Target (2days) - club receives \$10 per archer per day
 - Short Range (1 day) - club receives \$10 per archer
 - Flight - NA in 2012 as QRA is to be used (in other years a host club has received \$5 per archer)
 - Clout - club receives \$5 per archer
 - Indoor (2 days) - club receives \$5 per archer per day
 - Field - NA as SQAS field course is used
- SQAS shall receive the remaining fee income to cover FITA registration (\$90), judges fees, medals and engraving, target faces and other SQAS expenses and profit.
- Normal wear and tear and grounds preparation and maintenance will be met by the host club.
- SQAS will arrange before the start of the year any FITA registrations (\$90) when the annual SQAS calendar is developed.

For (C) Target QRE ranking events the host club is responsible for advertising, arranging judges and paying judges for expenses, and shall meet all costs and receive the fees collected.

General

Host clubs are to send details of the event and venue to the SQAS Tournament Secretary at least 8 weeks prior to the event.

The event should be advertised at least 6 weeks prior to the date of the shoot and nominations should close 2 weeks prior and advice forwarded to the SQAS by the host club to enable medals to be engraved in time.

A late fee of 50 percent of the fee may be applied if advised on the advertising.

The award of medals for late entries is at the discretion of the SQAS and the Organising Committee.
