2009 AUSTRALIAN YOUTH OLYMPIC FESTIVAL

TEAM SELECTION CRITERIA



1. OVERVIEW

- 1.1 The 2009 Australian Youth Olympic Festival (AYOF) is an important development and high performance event for potential Olympic athletes. Conducted and funded by the Australian Olympic Committee Archery has again been included in the 2009 program.
- 1.2 The 2009 Australian Youth Olympic Festival (AYOF) will be conducted at Sydney Olympic Archery Centre Bennelong Road Homebush Bay from the 14 to 18 January 2009.
- 1.3 The Australian Olympic Committee will provide appointed members of the Australian Team with interstate travel, accommodation and meals. Participants will be required to pay an Entry Fee of \$Aust 100.00.
- 1.4 Archery Australia will provide team members with a uniform.
- 1.5 There will be a total of 36 competitors, 18 male and 18 female. The Archery Australia team will consist of 3 male and 3 female members. Invitations have been sent to Malaysia, Great Britain, Chinese Taipei, USA and India.
- 1.6 As the 2009 Australian Youth Olympic Festival (AYOF) is an event funded and supported by the Australian Olympic Committee it will be open only to recurve archers.
- 1.7 The program for the 2009 Australian Youth Olympic Festival (AYOF) will be –

- 1.8 All shooting will be conducted at 70m
- 1.9 The Australian Olympic Committee through Archery Australia will appoint Team Managers and Team Coaches who will be responsible for the conduct of the team during the tournament as well as pre-tournament activities.
- 1.10 Due to time restraints and the cost of Selection Shoots, archers will be ranked based on the MQS submitted and the archers with the highest 3 scores will be select.

2. PROCESS

- 2.1 To be considered for selection archers must –
- a) Obtain the required Minimum Qualifying Score (MQS) and
 - b) Register with Archery Australia submitting the registration form and paying the registration fee.
 - c) Sign the Team Agreement
- 2.2 Registrations close on the 7th November 2008 with the Archery Australia Chief Executive Officer.
- 2.3 The Minimum Qualifying Scores (MQS) and rounds are –

- 2.4 Minimum Qualifying Score can be shot from 1st April 2008 to 2nd November 2008 in International, National, State and state sanctioned event or QRE.
- 2.5 The closing date for registration and submission of the application form is the 7th November 2008 with the Archery Australia Chief Executive Officer.

3. AGE DIVISIONS

- 3.1 Archery Australia will select 3 Male and 3 Female archers. To be eligible for team selection archers must be 18 years or under (18th birthday before 31st December 2009) and have not represented Australian in an Olympic games.
