



2009 WORLD YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS
SELECTION PROCEDURE

1. OVERVIEW

- 1.1 The 2009 World Youth Championships is a major event in 2009 and Archery Australia is intending to send a team to the Championships.
- 1.2 The 2009 World Youth Championships will be conducted in Salt Lake City USA from the 11-19 July 2009.
- 1.3 Team funding will be in line with current Archery Australia team funding policy, Archery Australia will cover Entry Fees and uniform. Each competitor will be responsible for all other costs, unless covered by the ASC and ACGA funding.
- 1.4 Archery Australia can enter a team of 24 junior archers in 2 age categories: Junior and Cadet.
- 1.5 There can be up to 12 Junior archers shooting in 4 categories - 3 Junior Men Recurve, 3 Junior Men Compound, 3 Junior Women Recurve, 3 Junior Women Compound
- 1.6 There can be up to 12 Cadet archers shooting in 4 categories - 3 Cadet Men Recurve, 3 Cadet Men Compound, 3 Cadet Women Recurve, 3 Cadet Women Compound
- 1.7 Archery Australia will appoint a Team Manager and a Team Coach who will be responsible for the planning, preparation and conduct of the team during the championships.

2. PROCESS

- 2.1 To first be considered for selection, archers must -
 - a) Obtain the required Minimum Qualifying Score (MQS) and
 - b) Register with Archery Australia submitting the registration form and paying the registration fee.
 - c) Complete the Team Agreement prior to Team Selection.
- 2.2 Registrations close at 5pm on Tuesday 1st January 2009 with the Archery Australia Chief Executive Officer.
- 2.3 The Minimum Qualifying Scores (MQS) and rounds are –

- 2.4 Minimum Qualifying Scores can be shot from 1st April 2008 in International, National, State and State sanctioned events and QRE's until 31st December 2008.
- 2.5 Selection will be determined from scores shot during a double target event at the 2009 Junior National Championships in Melbourne. Archers seeking selection must shoot the appropriate rounds at the National Championships to be shot at the World Youth Championships.

- 2.6 Following the selection shoot, the Archery Australia Selection Committee shall nominate the 3 highest ranked registered archers in each eligible category to the Archery Australia Board for ratification.

3. AGE DIVISIONS

- 3.1 There are two-age divisions contested at World Youth Championships: Junior and Cadet.
- 3.2 Under FITA rules a Cadet may participate when the competition takes place up to and in the year of his or her 16th birthday. A Cadet competitor may choose to compete in the junior class.
- 3.3 Under FITA rules a Junior may participate when the competition takes place up to and in the year of his or her 18th birthday.
